Putting on a Show Lockdown Project

Task 1: Researching Theatre genres

There are lots of different theatre genres, and when putting on a show you must consider them all! Research three of the below list of genres:

- Comedy
- Tragedy
- Farse/Slapstick
- Pantomime
- Musical
- Physical
- Melodrama
- Shakespeare
- Brechtian

Try to find out what the features of each genre is and find five examples of play or performance for each genre you explore. You should include a picture of the play and a short description of what it is about.

Task 2: Choosing your play

Now you have researched some different genres of theatre, you need to decide which play you will put on at your venue. You can either choose one of the five that you already explored or find a new play from another search.

Once you have chosen, find/draw a picture of it and write what it is about. Say why you have chosen this play, what is it that you like about it?

Task 3: Theatre poster

Next, using the research you have found create a poster advertising your chosen play at your theatre venue. You might want to leave space on the design for any famous actors that you may want to put in it at a later date.

Save your work:

If you are using a computer, open a blank document to do your work (you can use Word or Publisher). Don't forget to SAVE it with your name, the lesson you are doing and the date.
